Qualified and awarded applicants may be eligible for up to \$24,999 in exterior repairs or energy efficiency to their homes through a deferred forgivable loan over a five-year period following construction. The cost of the rehabilitation will be completely free if the homeowner remains in their home for five years following the project.
